Expanding Use of Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF).

JetBlue has entered into a new relationship with World Energy and World Fuel Services for SAF at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). This increase in the airline's usage of SAF includes 1.5 million gallons of blended SAF a year, accounting for approximately five percent of JetBlue's LAX fuel. This follows JetBlue's move to fuel flights from San Francisco International Airport (SFO) with SAF with another fuel provider.
