JetBlue is ready to disrupt the market with a new service from London starting this Summer, followed by Boston in Summer 2022.

JetBlue announced it will make its highly anticipated entrance into the transatlantic market with a nonstop service between London Heathrow Airport (LHR) and New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) commencing 12 August 2021. An additional service between London Gatwick Airport (LGW) and New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) will commence 30 September 2021.

Flights on both routes will operate daily on JetBlue's new Airbus A321LR (Long Range) aircraft with 24 reimagined Mint Suites (business class), 117 Core seats (economy class) and the sleek and spacious Airspace cabin interior.

Carry-on Bags for Blue Basic

Bookings combining two Blue Basic fare components “end-on-end” issued under one

ticket, including a transatlantic and onward JetBlue connecting flight, will be permitted a carry-on bag for the entire journey free of charge per the transatlantic baggage allowance. Please note, those issuing completely separate tickets will still be treated as per the original rules intent.
