JetBlue was initially welcomed at Heathrow with temporary slots made available as entrenched, larger airlines reduced service during the pandemic. Since its successful transatlantic launch in August 2021, JetBlue has worked with the local authorities to ensure it can continue to shake up the route with much needed competition.

Holding Non-refundable Tickets in Credit

Non-refundable tickets can be held in credit for use within one year from the original date of issue. If your customer is unable to travel and unsure of new dates, please cancel the segments out of the PNR prior to the first date of departure and keep note of the ticket number. The ticket should remain in OPEN status.

Once your customer knows when they would like to rebook for, please hold flights of an equal or greater value in a new PNR and reissue the OPEN status ticket against the new flights, collecting the change fee (if applicable) and any additional upgrade in fare.

Seat selections including Even More Space and Mint Studio have now been rolled out in Amadeus, Sabre and Travelport via EMD. We are currently working closely with our GDS partners to add pre-paid baggage to our EMD offering, but in the meantime please access the ticketed reservation in Manage Trips on jetblue.com to add checked baggage prior to check in.

JetBlue recently transitioned to an all-paid "chargeable" seat map. If a customer selects a fare option that includes a free seat assignment, the seat map will indicate there is a fee of £0. Unfortunately, Concur is unable to differentiate between our complimentary seats and our upgradable seats so, in order to reduce confusion and ensure a better travel experience, we have elected to remove our seat map from concur. To select seat assignments when booking via Concur, seating can be allocated via the GDS or travellers can manage their booking via JetBlue.com.
