


Launch of second flight LGW JFK



front of them in Core. Special meals are available however, not all special meals need to be requested prior to the flights. Gluten and vegetarian meals are always included in the dining options; therefore, it is not necessary to reserve these before the flight. Requests made through the GDS will come back as NO. All other special meals can be requested up to 24 hours prior to departure.
