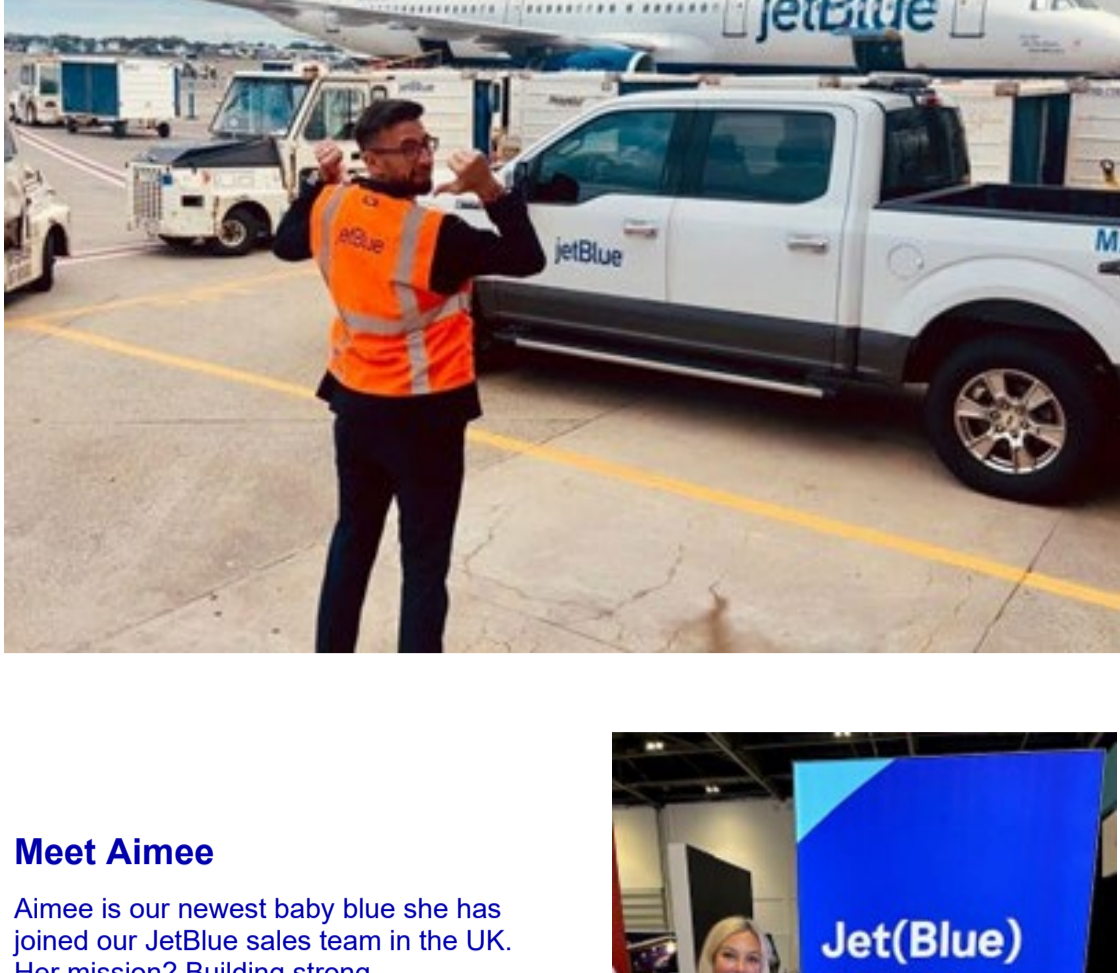

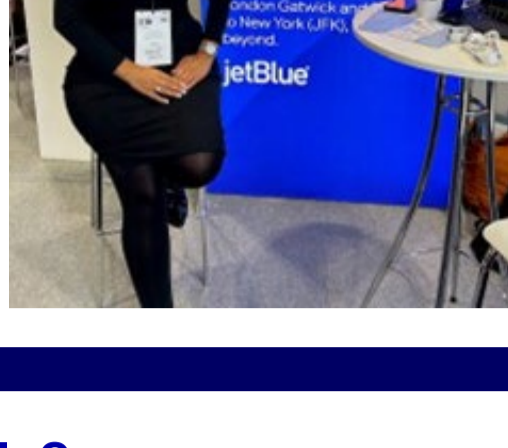
Team Updates

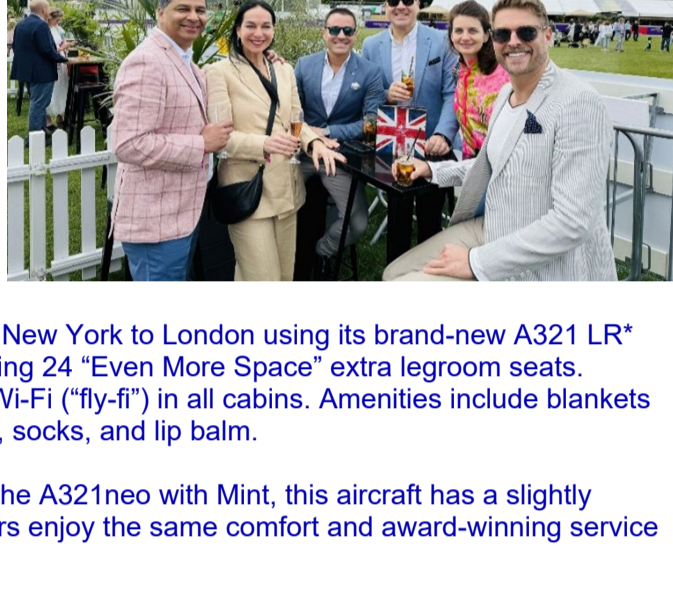

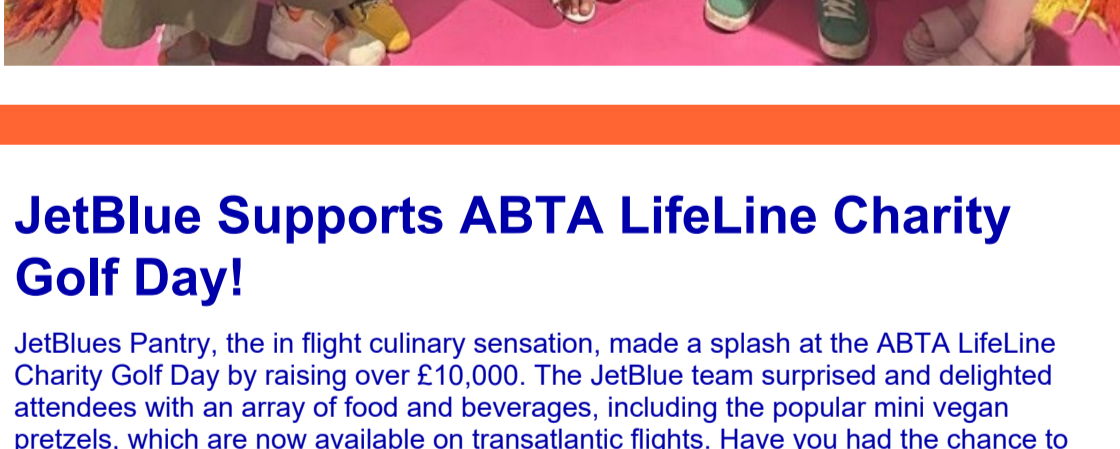


Edinburgh Fringe Festival

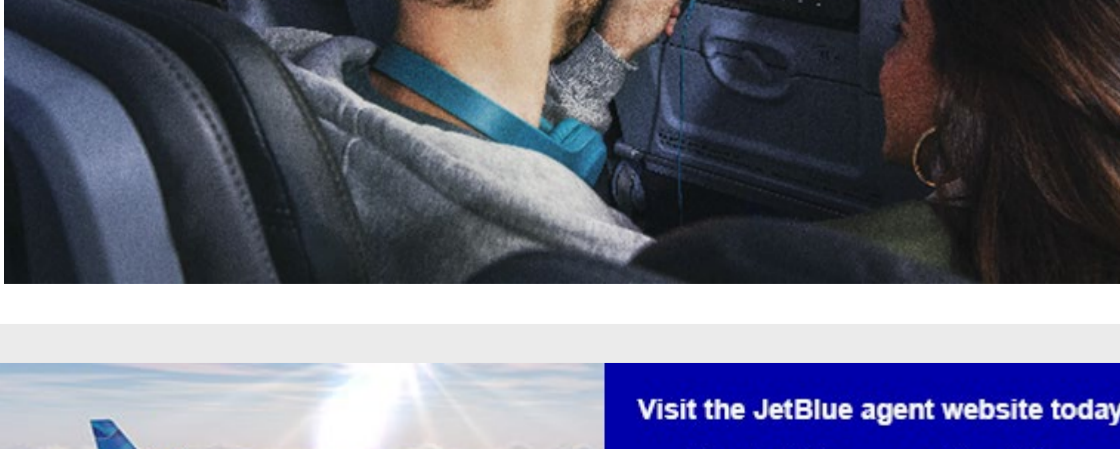
